

**ORDINANCE NO. 17-2017**

**AN ORDINANCE TO MAKE ADDITIONAL  
APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT YEAR  
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, it is immediately necessary to appropriate additional funds in various Funds in order to pay the outstanding bills and obligations of the Village of Loudonville, Ohio; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:**

**SECTION 1:** That the following sums of money be set aside and appropriated as follows:

FUND	FUND ACCOUNT	ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION
5101: Water Fund	Capital Outlay	\$930,000
2901: Police Fund	Capital Outlay	\$5,000

**SECTION 2:** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the Village of Loudonville, Ohio, in that it is immediately necessary to appropriate such additional funds in order to pay the outstanding obligations of the Village of Loudonville, Ohio, and to prevent default thereon, and shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage.
