

ORDINANCE NO. 70-2018

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CURRENT YEAR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary to amend the permanent appropriations in various funds of the Village of Loudonville, Ohio; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the appropriations in the following funds be amended as follows:

FUND	FUND PROGRAM ACCOUNT	APPROPRIATION REDUCTIONS
4901: Street Improvement Fund	Capital Expenses (Butler St. Project)	(141,960)
4902: FEMA Fund	Capital Expenses (Exhaust System)	(80,269)
5101: Water Fund	Capital Expenses (Butler St. Project)	(66,090)
5201: Sewer Fund	Capital Expenses (Butler St. Project)	(45,700)
5601: Storm Drain Fund	Capital Expenses (Butler St. Project)	(81,250)

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the Village of Loudonville, Ohio, in that it is immediately necessary to amend the annual appropriations of such funds, and shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage.
