

**ORDINANCE NO. 43-2019**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE  
CURRENT YEAR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, it is immediately necessary to amend appropriations in various Funds in order to meet the financial needs and obligations of the Village of Loudonville, Ohio; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:**

**SECTION 1:** That the following sums of money be set aside and appropriated as follows:

FUND	FUND ACCOUNT	APPROPRIATION REVISION
1000: General Fund	In-Kind Donation	(15,000.00)
3101: Maintenance Building Bond Retirement Fund	Debt Service	1546.15
4203: Maintenance Building Project Fund	Capital	798.00

**SECTION 2:** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the Village of Loudonville, Ohio, in that it is immediately necessary to amend or appropriate such funds in order to record or pay the future anticipated obligations of the Village of Loudonville, Ohio, and to prevent default thereon, and shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage.
