

ORDINANCE 10-2019

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS FROM THE ASHLAND COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO NORTH JEFFERSON STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Loudonville is planning to make improvements to North Jefferson Street in the Village of Loudonville, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the Community Development Block Grant program.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the Ashland County Planning Commission Community Development Block Grant program for funds for improvements to North Jefferson Street in the Village of Loudonville.

Section 2: The Village Administrator is further authorized to complete any documentation and enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the Village of Loudonville, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to apply for said funding to make necessary improvements to North Jefferson Street for community safety. This Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force at the earliest date allowed by law.
