

ORDINANCE 16-2017
AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE
ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR
THE GRANTING OF AN EXCLUSIVE LICENSE FOR
THE COLLECTION OF SOLID AND SEMI-SOLID WASTE
AND OTHER MATERIALS

WHEREAS, the Codified Ordinances of the Village of Loudonville require that waste removal services in the Village of Loudonville be performed by a company holding an exclusive license for provision of the same; and

WHEREAS, the current license will soon expire; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the Village of Loudonville now wishes to advertise for bids to review for the purpose of issuing an exclusive license for waste removal;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the granting of an exclusive license for the provision of services for the collection and disposal of solid waste, semi-solid waste and other materials as set forth in Loudonville Codified Ordinance 1050.06. The Village Administrator shall advertise once every two weeks for a period of four (4) weeks. The Village of Loudonville reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to issue an exclusive license at the sole and absolute discretion of the Council of the Village of Loudonville.

SECTION 2: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare, because it is necessary to ensure continuity of sanitary waste removal for public health and safety, and as an emergency measure this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
