ORDINANCE NO. 30-2018

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ANNUAL INCREASES IN THE WATER AND SEWER BASE RATES OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE

WHEREAS, the Village of Loudonville faces continued increases in expenses for the maintenance and operations of the Village water and sewer systems; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Loudonville has determined that it is in the best interests of the Village to provide for a process of regular increases in the water and sewer base rates for Village utilities;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

- **SECTION 1.** That effective February 1, 2019, all Village of Loudonville base rates for water and/or sewer services shall increase two percent (2%) from their currently-established rates.
- **SECTION 2.** That all Village of Loudonville base rates for water and/or sewer services shall continue to increase an additional two percent (2%) on February 1 every calendar hereafter unless otherwise altered by the Council of the Village of Loudonville by future legislative action.
- **SECTION 3.** That the Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to take any actions necessary to implement these increases.
- **SECTION 4.** That any Ordinance of the Village of Loudonville that is in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance is hereby amended to conform hereto
- **SECTION 5.** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and related to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
