

**ORDINANCE NO. 42-2020**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PROVISION OF PAVING MATERIALS AND SERVICES FOR THE NORTH JEFFERSON / EAST CAMPBELL STREET RESURFACING PROJECT IN THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE**

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of Loudonville desires to enter into an agreement for the paving of Butler Street in the Village of Loudonville for the North Jefferson / East Campbell Street Resurfacing Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Loudonville has advertised for and accepted bids for said project as required by law; and

**WHEREAS**, Shelly and Sands, Inc. has submitted a bid to provide the necessary materials, equipment, and labor, and the Council of the Village of Loudonville wishes to accept that bid believing that it is the lowest, best, and most responsive bid submitted;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:**

**SECTION 1:** That the Village Administrator and Fiscal Officer of the Village of Loudonville are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Shelly and Sands, Inc. for the provision of paving materials, equipment, and labor for the North Jefferson / East Campbell Street Resurfacing Project, at a contract price of one hundred thirty-three thousand eight hundred twenty-six dollars (\$133,826.00), and pursuant to the terms set forth in the contract attached hereto as Exhibit A and the bid specifications and related documentation of the North Jefferson / East Campbell Street Resurfacing Project. The contract will be for the ordinary project bid and will not include the "Alternate Bid" set forth in the bid specifications. Said "Alternate Bid" is hereby rejected.

**SECTION 2:** The Village does hereby waive any bidding inconsistencies of the Shelly and Sands, Inc. bid submission and rejects all other bidders.

EXHIBIT A

CONTRACT FOR PAVING SERVICES AND MATERIALS

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 2020, by and between the VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE, hereinafter referred to as "Village" and \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor".

**WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Loudonville has accepted bids for the purchase of road materials and labor for street paving and resurfacing; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has accepted the bid of Contractor to furnish and apply said road paving materials and services.

**NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:**

1. Contractor agrees to furnish the Village, and Village agrees to purchase the road materials and labor for street paving and resurfacing, including surface preparation, set forth in the attached bid specifications and Contractor bid forms, which are incorporated in this agreement and made part hereof by reference.

The following specific requirements shall be met when providing and installing materials:

1. Contractor shall sweep area to be paved and adequately prepare the site for paving.
2. Contractor shall apply non-trackable tack coat at the rates established in the Project Bid Form Article 5, Items 3A and 3B.
3. Contractor shall apply and compact a state-approved limestone mixture per bid specifications in the Project Bid Form Article 5, 4A and 4B.
4. Joints shall be sealed with AC20 or equivalent at all pavement to pavement joints and pavement to curb joints.
5. All duties set forth in this Agreement shall be completed on or before \_\_\_\_\_.
