ORDINANCE 72-2018

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR THE LOUDONVILLE FIRE DEPARTMENT DIRECT SOURCE CAPTURE EXHAUST SYSTEM PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has found that the Village of Loudonville Fire Department is in need of a direct source capture exhaust system, and

WHEREAS, Council desires to advertise for bids for the construction and installation of a direct source capture exhaust system pursuant to certain specifications; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: The Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for two (2) consecutive weeks for the Loudonville Fire Department Direct Source Exhaust System Project in the Village of Loudonville as described in the specifications for the project of record with the Loudonville Fiscal Office.

Section 3: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the Village of Loudonville, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to provide for the health and safety of Village citizens and Loudonville Fire and emergency medical personnel. This Ordinance shall therefore take effect and be in force at the earliest date allowed by law.
