

RESOLUTION NO. 13-2019

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY IS OBSOLETE AND HAS NO VALUE AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO DISPOSE OF THE SAME AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The Council for the Village of Loudonville has voted to demolish certain buildings at 144 and 146 North Water Street in the Village of Loudonville; and

WHEREAS, The demolition of said buildings will result in debris, construction materials, and other remains from the buildings;

WHEREAS, The Council for the Village of Loudonville believes that the resulting materials are personal property with no value;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1. That the debris, construction materials, and other remains from the demolition of 144 and 146 North Water Street in the Village of Loudonville are obsolete and unfit for the use for which they were acquired and have no value. Pursuant to Ohio Revised code Section 721.15(C), the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and instructed to discard or salvage said personal property in his discretion.

SECTION 2. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, the emergency being the necessity of having sufficient space for secured storage of Village property, to provide for the public peace and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Loudonville by providing for the removal and disposition of building demolition debris and materials which will cause a dangerous environment if retained. Wherefore this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and upon its adoption and approval.
