

**RESOLUTION 35-2020**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS FOR A CONTRACT FOR STREET SURFACE PAVING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, it is immediately necessary to advertise for bids to secure street surface paving services and materials for utilization in the repair and re-paving of Village streets; and

**WHEREAS**, it is immediately necessary to provide for resurfacing of Village streets, through paving, so as to adequately maintain the rights of way within the Village of Loudonville, and hereby keep the same free from nuisance and hazard;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:**

**SECTION 1:** That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids, by method required by law, for a contract for street paving services and materials, including surface preparation, to apply street paving material on North Jefferson Street from East Washington Street to East Campbell Street, and East Campbell Street from North Union Street to Snyder Drive. Said advertisement shall include alternative bid options for potential improvements North Adams Street from East Washington Street to East Campbell Street. The improvements shall be pursuant to the specifications on file with the Fiscal Officer of the Village of Loudonville, which paving has an estimated cost of One Hundred Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$160,000.00). The Village reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids, including, but not limited to, potential alternative project portion bids.

**SECTION 2:** That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the Village of Loudonville, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to advertise for bids so that appropriate street maintenance and street improvements may be conducted at the earliest date possible, thus reducing the potential for property damage or injuries arising from unrepaired streets. This Resolution shall therefore take effect and be in force at the earliest date allowed by law.
