

RESOLUTION 37-2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S), AND FOR THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission(“OPWC”) State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Loudonville is planning to make capital improvements to North Adams Street in the Village of Loudonville, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds for improvements to North Adams Street in the Village of Loudonville.

SECTION 2: The Mayor and Village Administrator are authorized to complete any documentation and enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.
