RESOLUTION 51-2018

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING CAPITAL PROJECTS FUND 4902 TO BE KNOWN AS FEMA ASSISTANCE TO FIREFIGHTERS GRANT FUND FOR THE RECEIPT OF FUNDS TO BE SET ASIDE, ACCUMULATED AND DISTRIBUTED BY THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE FOR THE PROVISION OF EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Loudonville is the expected recipient of grant funds from the Federal Emergency Management Agency for the benefit of the Loudonville Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Loudonville wishes to create a fund to collect those grant funds and distribute the same;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

SECTION 1: The Mayor and Fiscal Officer are hereby authorized and directed to complete and submit a Request for Fund Approval to the Auditor of the State of Ohio for the creation of the FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Fund (4902).

SECTION 2: Upon said Request for Fund Approval being deemed approved by the Auditor of the State of Ohio, the FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Fund (4902) shall immediately be created in the Village Treasury.

SECTION 3: The funds in the FEMA Assistance to Firefighters Fund (4902) shall consist of grant funds received from the Federal Emergency Management Agency for use in said fund as well as any funds expended by the Council of the Village of Loudonville.
