## **RESOLUTION 71-2018**

A RESOLUTION REJECTING ALL BIDS RECEIVED FOR THE LOUDONVILLE FIRE DEPARTMENT DIRECT SOURCE EXHAUST SYSTEM PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS,** Council has advertised for bids for improvements to the Loudonville Village Fire Department; and

**WHEREAS,** all bids received failed to properly respond to the specifications of the project and, if alternatives provided for in the bids were used to comply with the specifications, the cost would surpass the total budget available for the project; and

**WHEREAS,** the Council of the Village of Loudonville must reject all bids and attempt to advertise the project with different specifications and plans in order to reach an agreement within the parameters of the project;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF LOUDONVILLE, STATE OF OHIO:

**SECTION 1:** That all bids received prior to the date of this Resolution for the Loudonville Fire Department Direct Source Exhaust System Project be and hereby are rejected.

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary to preserve the public peace, health and safety for the reason that immediate passage and implementation of this measure is necessary to allow the Village to restart the bidding project with new specifications so that the Village can move forward with improvements necessary for the Loudonville Fire Department to keep the Village employees therein safe and healthy; therefore, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
